We all loved your pamphlet. We are sending out 1200 copies in the forthcoming World Lit mailing. The only thing I would suggest is either further elaboration on some element of the theme or bring up some supplimentary material to increase the overall length. There was sure no deadwood. It was both very clear and very concise but there is spatial room for more to serve as a long standing pamphæet.

I have been thinking lately about trying to come up your way before the WLC-4. That way we could talk and plan a littee as well as enjoy the beauty. For sure, the material can be completed at WLC_4. To actually get approval and immediate publication though, I am going to be asking for a lot of strength and guidance. Doug has already brought up financing and as of our last conversation, he was calling the review form "our book". There is a publishing house in LA called something like Divorce or Devoors. I have only heard the name from several members. However the name goes, they have an excellent reputation for publishing works of a spiritual nature. They would probably be in a position to back the first edition in quantity of 50,000 or 100,000 copies. There must be a way to let them handle that part of publication within Traditions. Like a super special worker. Funds over publication costs to be placed at the disposal of the WSC or the WSB. That flow would knock out any difficulties with developing the WSO. They could hold all but a few hundred copies available to fill orders at WSO. As they go, and they will go quickly, pay them for the copies sold and get a few hundred more for distribution. The money on the side will increase and a growing number will be available for sale. Expenses relating to filling orders can be handled out of the flow. Expansion of the office can take place in a natural manner.

I m trying to get my plans made for the trip out your way but my little business is in rough shape. There is a rumor that the groups will give us financial support for the trip this time. I'll be there, no doubt, but my household is in a shambles. Nothing God can't handle but it's way beyond me.
