CLOSING STATEMENTS

The approval form of our book is out to the Fellowship now, available to all groups and members on a donation basis. Votes will be taken from members through the Service Structure to approve or disapprove the material as it is at the WSC in May. Over five weeks, twenty-four hours a day, of Literature Sub-Committee time has been spent to get the material to this point. A call has gone out to the Fellowship for additional stories to be sent in to a Conference to be held in Philadelphia, January 15, to 17th. The Philadelphia Conference will finalize the stories to be included in the Basic Text. The stories will then be printed and distributed to the Fellowship in time to be approved with the Basic Text material. Any other material will be dealt with in the appendices. The Review Form put out last February, 1981, contains appendices which will serve in the Basic Text. Corrections or additions should be forwarded to the Literature Committee immediately.

The Policy Sub-Committee held meetings and workshops at the Mid-South Regional Service Conference, November 1981. With members from nineteen states present, a revised Service Manual was drafted and sent out to the Fellowship for consideration. The Mid-South Conference also worked on pamphlet material and went over stories. The Literature Sub-Committee held meetings and elected a member to serve as acting Chairperson. The Mid-South RSC has initiated much work to be finalized at the WSC this year. The Policy Sub-Committee will hold a Conference at Atlanta, Georgia in February 1982. Literature Sub-Committee will co-ordinate the Philadelphia Conference and getting the material out to the Fellowship. Institutional Sub-Committee is considering holding a Conference. Interested members should contact the Chairperson in San Francisco.

Regions are encouraged to hold Service Conferences to initiate any further work to be finalized at the WSC this year. Members and areas can meet and study the book material, the Service Manual and their needs in general. The continuance and growth of the Fellowship involves each and every member. Service conferences provide a special opportunity to inform and hear from every member. Questions, ideas and other input for the WSC to deal with can be developed at these Service Conferences. All input to be placed on the pre-Conference agenda to be mailed out in February should be sent now to the WSC Chairperson for inclusion. This is important for the representatives who will be attending the WSC to have time to get a group conscious vote on major issues to be decided at the WSC in May.

We hope this report has helped bring you up to date. If you have something that should be included, please send it to the WSC Chairperson to go out in the next report.
