Personal Expense Allowance and Reimbursement for World Service Travel

World service travelers may claim reimbursement for specified expenses for each day of travel on an approved world service trip. Typical expenses allowed under the policy are for meals, transportation and ground transportation, parking fees, tolls, and tips. Allowance limitations are established by the US Internal Revenue Service for business travel in the US and by the US State Department for business travel outside the US. Those limitations as published will be used to administer this policy.

The Interim Committee will prepare a reimbursement package each year and present it to the conference at it's annual meeting. This package will contain the processes and procedures to be used by world service travelers, the type of expenses that can be reimbursed, the limits of reimbursement, which items require receipts, expense forms, advances, and how to submit claims for reimbursement. This package will then be distributed to all newly elected and continuing trusted servants.

Air transportation will be reserved and ticketed through the WSO or its agent, whenever possible. Travelers should make air travel arrangements as far in advance as possible. Travelers are responsible for their tickets once they have been received. The use of other modes of transportation is permitted, but only the most economical mode of transportation will be reimbursed.

It is the policy of NA world services to use reasonably priced facilities. Reimbursement for lodging commonly will be for double occupancy. NA world services does not reimburse for companion accompaniment.

Fraudulent claims or violations of the policy and/or procedures can result in one or more of the following actions:

Request for repayment of all unauthorized expenditures.

Rejection of reimbursement for submitted expenses.

Rejection of request for travel advance.

Suspension of trusted servant from office."

Credit Cards

In recent years we have found it productive to use credit cards to facilitate the service responsibilities of specific individuals in world services. The WSO maintains a policy on the use of credit cards for employee responsibilities and has since their initial use. It seems responsible to apply those parameters to credit card use for WSC responsibilities. These policies will ensure that credit card use conforms to a standard set of guidelines.

DISTRIBUTION OF CARDS

- A. The issuance of credit cards for WSC responsibilities is subject to the approval of the Interim Committee. Each person approved for credit card issuance shall be provided a Conditions of Authorized Use form, which must be completed, signed, and on file prior to issuance of a credit card. Credit cards will be routinely offered to the individual positions listed below:
 - 1. Chairperson of the WSO Board of Directors
 - 2. Chairperson of the World Service Board of Trustees
 - 3. Chairperson of the World Service Conference
 - 4. Chairperson of the World Convention Corporation

- 5. Executive Management of the World Service Office
- 6. WSO Managers
- B. The chairperson of one of the service arms identified above may designate the vice chairperson or any member of their respective service board or committee to be issued a credit card in lieu of the card being assigned to that chairperson.
- C. Board or committee members who reside outside the continental United States may be issued credit cards to facilitate the fulfillment of their service responsibilities, at the discretion of the Interim Committee.
- D. Boards and committee members may be issued credit cards on a temporary basis for a designated trip or function. All cards issued under this criteria will be returned to the WSO by registered mail within thirty days of completion of the trip or function. All invoices or other accompanying documentation shall be returned at the time of card surrender.
- E. All cards shall be returned within thirty days of the closure of the term of office of the card holder. All invoices or other accompanying documentation shall be returned at the time of card surrender.
- F. WSO executive staff shall have the authority to cancel all cards on the closure of a term of office based upon the surrender criteria outlined above.

CREDIT CARD EXPENDITURES

All expenditures on the credit card must be substantiated by the receipts issued at the time of card use. Individuals utilizing the credit cards will submit an expense statement accompanied by the invoice(s) resulting in card use—not the credit card slip, but the actual hotel bill, car rental agreement, etc. All receipts will be attached to the permanent record of the trip or function. World service credit cards shall not be used to cover personal expenses not directly related to the trip or function, even though the individual may intend to repay the conference for the expenditures. The WSC Interim Committee shall conduct quarterly audits and/or reviews of WSC credit card activity by all trusted servants and report such findings to the fellowship in the Conference Report.

CREDIT CARD MISUSE

Any alleged inappropriate and/or unauthorized credit card use, or persistent failure to submit appropriate documentation of credit card use, requires a thorough investigation by the committee. The committee will review all necessary documentation and request written statements of explanation from the individual involved and anyone else who may have knowledge of the situation. A determination will be made by the committee and reported to the fellowship. The determination of the committee can result in one or more of the following actions:

Reinstatement of credit card privileges, if previously removed.

Revocation of credit card privileges.

Request for repayment for all unauthorized expenditures.

Rejection of reimbursement for submitted expenses.

Suspension of trusted servants from office."

Intent: To allow the Narcotics Anonymous Fellowship to grow as an International Fellowship without burdening those outside the USSCNA with issues that are of concern only to the U.S. Fellowship; or, of only passing interest to the International Fellowship. To relieve the U.S. Fellowship of the burden of trying to resolve every issue outside of the U.S.

"World Services", as we know it today, has many obstacles. Good people of good will trying to do the most spiritual things for the Fellowship find their efforts diluted or destined to failure by cross efforts and issues that are beyond the scope of their activities.

The primary purpose of our Fellowship is to carry the message of recovery to the addict who still suffers. We have found that the best way to do this is to do it as locally as possible. Recovery meetings for the addicts close by. The local Areas provide the best general services to the addicts in those meetings because they are closest to them. The local Region provides the best resource for the local Areas because they are closest to that Area in customs; langauge; and, temperament. Then we come to a National Conference which is exactly whta "World Services" was until at least 1986! For seventeen of the twwenty-five years, we called the U.S. National Conference a 'World Service Conference'. The way we have structured "World Services"; and what we ask of it, is not the most efficient for either the U.S. or the International Fellowship.

Motion #50

AREA SERVICE CONFERENCE

INTRODUCTION

An Area Service Conference is established by and is responsible to the local fellowship of NA. The difference between an Area Service Conference and an Area Service Committee is not as much a difference in structure as it is a difference in procedure. An Area Service Conference is responsible to the Groups it serves, and any committees or sub-committees that are formed at the area level are directly responsible to the Groups. The Area Service Committee is an "Entity" and all of the participants are a part of that committee. An Area Service Conference is not an entity, it is an "Event", the coming together of all of the committees in the area with the representatives of the Groups ("GSRs"). All of the committees at the Area Service Conference are directly responsible to, and only to, the Groups.

The ASC is not an entity, it is an event - the coming together. Unlike all of the Groups or conference committees, the conference only exists while it is meeting. This monthly (or bi-monthly) event brings together representatives from every NA Group and representatives from every NA committee that the Groups have formed to join in and work together for the common welfare. The main goal of the chairperson is to maintain a productive working atmosphere that allows each service committee to present itself to the GSRs for support, direction, and approval of the current committee activities.

The main goals of the GSRs during the conference are:

- 1. To support the common welfare of the Groups and the unity of the Fellowship within the Area.
- 2. To communicate with, give support to, and direct each of the service committees that are directly responsible to those they serve.
- 3. Respond collectively to issues of concern or decisions that effect other Areas, the Region, or NA as a whole.

The Groups form committees at the conference to handle whatever functions are necessary or helpful to the Groups. These committees are formed when there is a specific need for them. Every project that the conference undertakes should relate directly to its purpose. The conference is responsible not only to develop and maintain committees in each field of service but to coordinate the work of each of those committees with the work of the others. For these reasons, all committee participants need to become as informed as they can possibly be about committee activities. The conference devotes a significant portion of the meeting to reports from committee chairpersons and discussion of committee activities.

The balance between accountability and delegation is a delicate one. If the Groups exert too much control over the committees, those committees will not be able to serve well. If the Groups delegate too much authority to its committees, on the other hand, the committees may lose focus of the purpose or direction that the Groups created them to fulfill.

CLASSIFICATION OF AREA SERVICE PARTICIPANTS

The participants of the Area Service Conference have several different purposes and functions. However, these are only three separate classifications of participants according to their role and their authority at the conference;

- 1. Representatives sent to represent the Groups (GSRs). the only voting participants.
- 2. Representatives or chairpersons of the committees and members of the Administrative committees
- 3. The Conference Chairperson- responsible for setting the agenda and maintaining order

THE GSR is the only voting participant at the Area Service Conference and has final authority for all decisions. Regardless of whether the GSR decides on an issue after taking it back to the "Home Group", or the decision is made at the conference, the role of the GSR is to represent the conscience of the Group at the ASC.

COMMITTEE CHAIRPERSONS or MEMBERS OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE COMMITTEE ARE are responsible for presenting the GSRs with all of the information and materials necessary for the GSRs to understand the present activities ,plans and needs of the committee or service position that they represent. The committee chairpersons are only representatives of the committees and come to the conference seeking support direction and approval for the activities of their committee from the Groups.

In accordance with our 9th Tradition, these boards and committees are established to serve only, not to govern. They are directly responsible to the Groups and are always subject to the explicit direction of the Groups. Although our service committees may do much to help our Groups fulfill their primary purpose, it is in the Groups where NA, as such, comes into focus, not in the boards and committees that serve them.

THE CONFERENCE CHAIRPERSON is the facilitator of the conference event, coordinating the process between the committees and the Groups. The role of the chairperson, while the conference is in session, is separate from responsibilities of the Admin. Committee or the JAC. The chair should remain neutral on all issues and should focus on the process of decision making, not the outcome of the decision. Recommendations or decisions made by the Administrative Committee or the Joint Administrative Committee (JAC) should be presented by the Vice Chairperson and allow the Chairperson the ability to remain neutral.

OUTREACH COMMITTEE:

I. Purpose of the Committee:

The purpose of the WSC Outreach Committee is to serve as a resource to the fellowship on "outreach" efforts.

II. Definition and Goals:

"Outreach" efforts are defined as those service activities designed to provide guidance for N.A. communities in their efforts to help develop and sustain N.A. Groups and to encourage their involvement in NA service. As a Committee, WSC Outreach does not directly do outreach to individuals, this is a function of the World Service Office and/or local Outreach subcommittees.

The goal of "outreach" efforts is to overcome isolation separating addicts within our Fellowship. Examples include: distance, geography, culture, and complacency. Outreach service is also designed to assist N.A. groups in institutions that are not directly served by an H&I subcommittee. Outreach efforts are intended to assist N.A. communities and isolated or institutional N.A. groups to develop and help themselves.

III. Functions of the committee:

The WSC Outreach Committee will provide guidance and assistance to N.A. Outreach subcommittees by:

- A. Creating simple service materials, to include the Outreach Handbook.
- B. Facilitating the exchange of information and experience between N.A. Outreach Subcommittees.
- C. Working closely with WSO to facilitate and encourage registrations of N.A. groups and outreach subcommittees.

IV. Outreach Committee authority and responsibility:

The Outreach committee is directly responsible to those it serves through the World Service Conference. The committee reports to the WSC and follows such direction as the WSC may give.

V. Outreach Committee membership:

The voting membership shall consist of 7 members. The chair and vice-chair shall be elected by the WSC, each to serve one-year terms. Other voting members serve for a two year term and shall not serve more than two consecutive terms. Vacancies in voting membership will be filled by election from the pool, at the next Committee meeting. Members elected to fill vacant voting positions will serve two years plus the remainder of the conference year in which they are elected. A pool of Associate members are appointed by the chair and vice chair from the list of Interested members. This committee shall utilize the resources of special workers as appointed by the WSO Administrative Team.

MOTION #4 TIMELINE

If any motion is adopted that requires a group tally vote the following process and timeline will be considered:

Motion Development

- Prior to the close of the conference the motion will be developed that will be considered by the fellowship through the group tally.
- Once developed the motion will be adopted by the WSC prior to the end of the conference.
- Every effort will be made to translate the motion and subsequent forms into all represented language groups.

Development of the group tally data base

- Within 60 days, RSR's will be given registration forms to disseminate to the groups within their regions to
 gather those groups desiring to register for the group tally. In addition, registration forms will be sent to all
 groups currently in the Group Services database. All forms will be returned to the RSR at a verified address.
- RSR's will determine the best process to obtain group registrations. Those registrations shall contain group name and mailing address.
- All registration lists must be received by March 1st of the year under consideration.
- 60 days prior to the deadline the WSO will mail to all RSCs the current status of their respective group registrations, so that they can determine how many of their groups still have not registered.
- The Board of Trustees will report to the conference on the number of registrations in the group tally data base, along with the number of groups currently contained in the group services data base.
- At the WSC the Board of Trustees will provide the conference with a motion to consider the validity of the data base, based on a comparison between the group tally database and the Group Services database..
- If the conference rejects the data base, a decision will be made by the conference to either develop a new data base, or discontinue action on the motion.

The Group Tally Vote'

- If the data base is considered valid by the conference, coded group tally forms will be sent directly to all groups registering for the group tally. All forms will be accompanied with a self-addressed return envelope to a registered post office box.
- The process for tabulating the votes will be adopted by conference participants after the WSB investigates all
 available options and a financial study has been done.
- All forms must be postmarked no later than November 15th, in order to have them tabulated in time to be published in the Conference Agenda Report.
- If the result of the tally is in the affirmative, the WSB will submit a motion in the CAR to affirm the results by an RSR vote at the conference per the FIPT.

Adoption Criteria

- In order for the tally to be valid, 75% of the groups who registered in the above named period must participate by responding.
- For each decision to pass, 75% of the groups who respond must vote in the affirmative.
- 2/3 of the RSRs must vote to affirm the action as per FIPT.
