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| 16. | That the members of the HRP be considered as scheduled members of the World Service Travel Teams that visit fellowships within their local zonal communities | No action intended |
| 17. | That the WSC recognize, as fully recognized Conference Participants representing NA communities yet without a vocal and spiritual link between them and the WSC, the Chairpersons of the Latin American, the European and the Asia-Pacific Forums as the voices and voting participants of both their established and developing communities and as the conduits through which official information is transmitted and by which the community consciences and spiritual pulses between their zones and NA World Services may be expressed; such as Denmark, Finland, Russia, Poland, The Czech Republic, Belgium, Holland, Greece, Turkey, Bolivia, Chile, Uruguay, Venezuela, El Salvador, Guatemala, Malaysia, Hong Kong, Thailand, Pakistan, Nepal and other isolated communities within these zones. | No action intended |
| 18. | That the WB send a notice to our fellowship suggesting that each group in the world pass a special basket during the first week of August '00 to collect funds to be specifically used for the translation of our literature into languages of countries that have suffering addicts that need help. | No action intended |
| 19. | To develop a "Travel Team Host" application that NA members around the world can use for being considered as a host for one or more World Service Travel Team Members that may arrive in their city for an NA function or other World Service business | No action intended |
| 20. | That the WB ask individual members of the worldwide NA fellowship to become Travel Team Hosts by submitting applications to the HRP for providing lodging accommodations for Standing Committee Members and Active Pool Members of the WB, WSO special workers and other Travel Team Members who are traveling within a zonal community, including zones within the United States or to the WSO. | No action intended |
| 21. | To begin developing a plan that, when workable – which should not be less than regular, makes a way for World Service Travel Team Members to lodge in the homes of Travel Team Hosts and not in hotels | No action intended |
| 22. | To develop a set of guidelines to be used by the World Service Travel Team Members and Travel Team Hosts | No action intended |
| 23. | That, for World Service Travel Teams, the HRP have the responsibility of choosing housing locations within our zonal communities from applications received from Travel Team Hosts of our zonal fellowships and the WSO area | No action intended |
| 24. | That a maximum tour of duty that a recovering addict may be employed by World Services, excluding the literature production, handling and distribution departments, be determined. For example, 5, 10, 15, 20, or 25 years | No action intended |
| 25. | That a plan be developed, using either Standing Committee Members or Active Pool Members of the World Board as figures of authority and points of contact and relayed information, that institutes a way in which the WSO administration and fellowship services teams may interact with our Fellowship from a position of total personal anonymity when responding to inquiries of members, prospective members, trusted servants or service committees | No action intended |

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| 26. | That all letters produced by World Services and sent to any member or service committee of NA concerning policy suggestions, internal NA community disputes, service structure development or maintenance or any other service issue be first read, approved, and, as necessary, upgraded or altered by a Standing Committee Member or Active Pool Member of the World Board. | No action intended |
| 27. | That all letters sent from the World Services to any member, perspective member, elected trusted servant, service committee of NA or the like shall not include a name of any trusted servant or special worker but only the name of the committee or department and a letter identification number, unless the person or committee specifically requests a document produced by an individual identifying themselves | No action intended |
| 28. | That the Narcotics Anonymous Fellowship begin using a Termed Tour Employment Program to be developed, incorporated and guided by the present WSO administration, and approved by the World Service Conference, in accordance with the following as guidelines: The WSO administration shall; (1) envision and project the balanced and fluid reallocation of individual assignment responsibilities as a function of determined employment tours; (2) develop and incorporate a rotational scheme that redistributes and adjusts the responsibilities of those entering into, moving through and exiting out of World Service employment, relative to the position in time within their tour, while maximizing and accentuating the skills particular to their type of service work; (3) develop and incorporate a Spiritual Development, Integration and Support Program, internal, peculiar to and a part of World Service employment, that promotes a flourishing atmosphere of unity, growth, purpose and love amongst the servant staff; (4) develop and incorporate a two year Transitional Program that prepares a member for existing out of their tour and entering into another field of work that provides a comparable atmosphere of accomplishment and a comparable level of income and opportunity for position advancement; (5) develop and incorporate a Post Tour Program that includes (a) active involvement in maintaining and refining the Spiritual Development, Integration and Support Program, using the toured member as a source of guidance and strength for providing encouragement and support to the yet touring members, (b) active participation by the toured members in any interoffice boards or panels designed to improve and refine the internal schematics of the WSO and, (c) any other involvement seen by the administration to aid in developing and strengthening of the WSO; and (6) develop and incorporate any other internal programs that should accomplish the intent of this motion. | No action intended |
| 29. | That the World Board Publications Committee publish any type of literature that includes the SUGGESTION that "every NA member in the world, with 3 or more months in recovery, participate in a service commitment, if only through attending one H&I meetings per month | No action intended |
| 30. | To move the administrative staff, fellowship services staff and related supporting departments and the location of the World Service Office every 12 years, excluding the literature production, handling and distribution departments and staff | No action intended |
| 31. | To have the location of the next World Service Office, excluding the literature production, handling and distribution departments and staff, in either North Carolina, Florida, Dallas, Chicago, Detroit, Washington DC, New York City, Stockholm, Berlin, Dublin, London or Portugal | No action intended |

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| 32. | That an agreement be drafted, or the like, that current and future Standing Committee Members of the World Board and WSO special workers must sign, as a part of their service commitment or tour of employment, that requires that any books or materials produced by them, that offers any type of information about their experiences or anything else that is about or related to the NA Program or Fellowship, shall be made the property of the WSC | No action intended |
| 33. | That the summer of 2000 edition of the NA Way Magazine be the last edition that displays the names and job titles associated with the production of the magazine | Took out all unnecessary references that are not required for publications beginning in April 2000. |
