RE: Recommendations for the Inventory Process

DATE: November 26, 1993

In following the suggestion in the recent inventory updates, the New Jersey RSC would like to recommend the following changes in the inventory process. These concerns were discussed in the Multi-Regional meetings in New York and Ocean City, MD. Our Region discussed these issues at our November RSC and voted to recommend the following changes to the World inventory process.

Recommendation #1: That all World inventory Composite Group members be funded to attend the January 1994 World Service meeting in New Orleans.

Reason: The World Service Conference body may need to give the Composite Group further direction or clarification in regard to changes and new developments of the inventory process. The composite group has not received any formal direction from the WSC body since the May Conference. This meeting would be the perfect time to review exactly where we have gone with the inventory since May. Rather than guessing as to whether all of the changes have been within the will of the Conference, it would be better to sit down together and receive either support or direction for the course we are taking.

Recommendation #2: That Part 1 and Part 2 of the WSC Committee Survey be sent to all WSC Committee members, including Committee pool, registered, and general members that have participated during the last five years. The Composite Group is also asked to recommend to the committees that these members be included in the inventory process as non-funded members.

Reason: The process of doing an inventory, whether on a personal or world level, is to better understand what qualities, practices, morals and beliefs that we have, and also what qualities, practices, morals and beliefs that we don't have. By including former members of our World Service committees, we will receive a better insight of the nature of World Services. Many of our World Service trusted servants leave World Service because their need to serve at this level has been fulfilled. Some of our trusted servants leave World Service because of "burn out" or frustration. The purpose of this recommendation is not to try to deal with the age-old resentment list of some of our earliest World Service trusted servants. Those issues probably need to be dealt with later in the inventory, but not now. We do need to include our most recent members to get a true insight of the nature of World Services today.

The New Jersey Region is grateful for the dedication and effort that the members of both the Composite Group and the Interim Committee have shown during this inventory process. Our Region is willing to support the WSC in any way possible to further carry the message to the Addict that still suffers.
