Re: Literature Priorities Survey

First of all, we would like to thank those of you who responded to our previous literature survey. That brief survey asked you to provide us with two pieces of information: how you perceive the role of regional and area literature committees in the literature development process and how you would prioritize the work on our current work lists. Your answers for the first question will be instrumental in guiding the work of the handbook working group as they make revisions in our current literature handbook. Answers to the second question helped the evaluations subcommittee make recommendations to the WSCLC concerning our work list proposal for 1993.

We would now like you to help us determine the fellowship's literature needs, functions, and priorities in a more detailed way. We are asking you to rate a number of current roles of individuals, groups, and committees in the literature process, then to look at literature needs on a more global level. This information will be used to check that our purposes as stated in the literature guidelines are still appropriate and to assist us in rewriting our handbook.

We are also requesting that you identify the specific literature functions your regional or area committee fulfills. We are aware that some committees do not serve as literature review bodies and that some regional literature committees really have two separate subcommittees. We strive to send review material to the appropriate committee, but sometimes miss the mark. Your identifying these functions will not only help us get the right information to the appropriate committee, but will also allow us to see how widespread the practice of reviewing literature is. We also believe that our ability to communicate with you will be enhanced if we better understand the scope of functions currently served by literature committees.

Please note that we are asking you to widely distribute this survey. The information will be most valuable if we receive responses from a wide range of recovering addicts. Your input is due at the WSO Literature Department by April 1, 1993.
